Security Measures Intensified in and around Sana'a

The Ministry of Interior started an aggressive campaign last week to intensify security in and around the capital, Sana'a, in order to monitor and crack down on security breakdowns in the city, defining specific access and outgoing routes to the city. Sana'a has been a good place for tribesmen to settle their scores, mainly tribal vengeance. It appears that this measure also aims to prevent terrorists, kidnappers and other lawless people from entering the capital, as most of the kidnapping incidents, which President Saleh denounced earlier as terrorist acts, have taken place in the capital.

Reliable sources told Yemen Times that last week's visit of a Jordanian military team was meant to assist the Yemeni security authorities in applying advanced schemes to monitor main routes into the country and main cities which would enable them to crack down on terrorists and other outlaws.

No Casualties in Explosion at Canadian Nexen Site

The bomb that exploded last Wednesday in the oil vulcanizing center of the Canadian Nexen oil company in Hadramaut caused no causalities, but resulted in slight damage to some of the cars parked near the office. The explosion, which took place in al-Musilah area, 140 km away from the exporting port in al-Shehe'r, coincided with the presence of the company's Vice President for Oil and Gas Affairs, who paid a visit to Yemen last week.

The Yemeni police in Hadhramaut refused to comment on the incident. Reliable sources said that Canadian Nexen moved most of its foreign staff to this place after the September 11 terrorist attacks in the USA, believing it to be the most secure place. The sources added security was tightened around the building. The exploded center built by Canadian Nexen provides services to three oil companies in the

area: the French Total, the British Dove and D.N.O. Yemen produces around 480,000 barrels of oil per day.

President Saleh to Visit the Netherlands

Sources close to the Yemeni presidency said that President Ali Abdullah Saleh will be visiting the Netherlands by the end of this

The sources added that the President will discuss with the Dutch Prime Minister bilateral relations, as well as the ongoing events relating to the Palestinian cause and Afghanistan, in addition to the efforts to fight terrorism on a worldwide scale.

The government of the Netherlands is one of the most important donors to Yemen. It annually offers generous support for different aspects of development in the country.

The President's visit will also cover the USA and some European countries. Saleh is expected to meet the US president George W. Bush at the White House on November 27. He is also expected to meet other high-ranking US officials.

The US Ambassador to Sana'a, Edmund Hull, had earlier left Yemen for the US to prepare for Saleh's visit.



Two Yemenis Stand Trial in the USA

Saba News Agency revealed that a hearing for a case filed against two Yemeni aviation students in San Francisco, USA is to be held next Thursday. According to 26 September Weekly, Yemeni Defense Minister Abdullah Ali Elewa said, "Two Yemenis studying aviation in the United States are to stand trial for charges that are as of vet unknown."

The two students, identified by the newspaper as N Assanabani and W. Sabra, were initially detained based on illegal immigration status, but according to SABA,



"No Development without Security"

es indeed. There could be "no development without security and no security without development," a sentence I quote from a speech of H.E. Edmund Hull, US Ambassador to Yemen during the seminar organized by Yemen Times more than two weeks ago.

The truth in this statement is undeniable. It reflects thorough experience and understanding of the conditions that arise as consequences of others. I have heard it from many businessmen. "We cannot invest in this country unless there is true stability and security," they say. And they are right!

If you cannot guarantee your rights because of the lack of security or because of an inefficient or corrupt judicial system, then how can you invest in the country? Unfortunately, we are in a time in which insecurity has caused businessmen to refrain from investing and some donors from donating. It is about time that the government gives the issue of security the attention it deserves. This cannot be accomplished by placing checkpoints for inspecting vehicles and people. It can only be accomplished once there is respect for the law. Only when the rich and poor, strong and weak, all abide by the laws and regulations, will we be able to establish security and hence pros-

President Saleh had said it many times. Prime Ministers of consecutive governments have also confirmed it. Without law and order, we can neither have security, nor will we prosper. Just today, I have witnessed more than three traffic violations committed by different vehicles belonging to the army and tribesmen, while the traffic officer was merely watching. It is obvious that he was afraid of confronting those powerful individuals, who see themselves as above the law.

This scenario repeats itself everywhere in the country and in different circles. The law seems to be implementable only on the weak, while the strong are most of the time exempted.

This calls for serious reconsideration of our system of governance and study: why those things are happening, why the government is seen to be so weak by the public, and why some figures still see themselves as above the law.

This phenomenon reflects itself clearly on society in having some tribesmen continue to carry their weapons in cities and to kidnap foreigners. How many times have tribesmen kidnapped foreigners and then are let go after tribal mediation and arbitration? I have heard of true stories of some who even became government officials.

To put it another way, in Yemen, tribalism can sometimes overpower the law, which results in a situation of lawlessness and disrespect for the constitutional regulations. Hence, security problems continue to exist and to grow in number and in

Hence, it is only logical to see that lawlessness leads to insecurity, and insecurity leads to more backwardness.

This is exactly what we don't want. This is what we oppose and hope the leadership can bring an end to. And I believe that this is what the ambassador meant by saying that there could be "no development without security."


I hope our officials get the message!

YJS Launches Solidarity Campaign with Palestinian Journalists

The Yemeni Journalist Syndicate (YJS) launched last Wednesday, a solidarity campaign with the Palestinian journalists at the Press Center in Sana'a. Chairman of the YJS and Head of the Palestine Committee of the Arab Journalists Federation, Mr. Mahboob Ali, delivered a speech in which he stressed that the Palestinian issue has entered a dangerous turning point in its history.

Mr. Na'aym al-Tuyassi, Chairman of the Palestinian Journalist Syndicate, expressed his appreciation of the stance of Yemeni journalists and people, who have been always on the side of the Palestinian people. Mr. al-Tuyassi also declared the establishment of a press center in Jerusalem so as to play a role in supporting the Palestinian cause, adding that the starting point of this center was from Yemen through raising donations for the Palestinian people. On his part, Foreign Minster, Dr. Abu Bakr al-Qirbi, condemned in his words, "the Israeli terrorism" and

stressed the necessity of making Israel adhere to international law, adding that the government committee has so far raised roughly YR 600 million for supporting the Palestinian people.

Similarly, Mr. Waleed Abdulaziz al-Saqqaf delivered a speech on behalf of the independent newspapers in which he stressed the important role that the Arab media can play in communicating the views of Arabs, particularly in the wake of the September 11 attacks. Mr. Waleed al-Saqqaf also highlighted the role of the official media in reporting the views of the public about the current events in the Middle East in ways that favorably influence the US public. "Yemen Times, as a weekly English paper, tries vigorously to report the Israeli atrocities to the whole world," Waleed al-Saqqaf added. Yemen Times donated YR 200,000 to the Palestinian journalists, while the YJS is still collecting donations, which presently total US\$10,000.

General Corporation for Salt Awarded

The Golden Prize for Quality was awarded to the General Corporation for Salt last Tuesday, November 13 2001. The celebration was organized in the building of the corporation. The General Manager of the Foreign Ministry Office, Mohammed Al-Azzani, awarded the Golden Prize to the General Manager of the Corporation, Abdulrahman Hassan Abdullah. Mohammed Al-Azzani delivered a speech focusing on the activities of the corporation and the development of salt production in Yemen, specifically in Aden. The prize was awarded to the corporation because of its high standards of quality and for being the first corporation to iodized salt in Yemen. The corpora-

tion has conducted several changes in techniques and the ways of work and could produce between 120 to 150 thousand tons. The corporation's exports from January to October, 2001 totaled 41 thousand tons at the cost of YR 144,271,000. The General Manager of the Corporation, Abdulrahman Hassan Abdullah, added that the corporation has been looking for new markets for salts to be exported to. It is expected that the sales of the corporation will reach between 40 to 60 thousand tons per year. He pointed out that the corporation has successfully achieved great benefits.

The corporation was founded in 1886 and it was awarded the Bronze Prize in 1989.

"In the ultimate analysis, it is the Afghan people who will have to work for national reconciliation"

o doubt the development of the terrorist against Washington and New York put Pakistan in a very critical position. Being torn between the American pressure to support attacks on Afghanistan and that of a significant portion of the Pakistani public, Pakistan seems forced to make every effort to strike a balance between the two. To have a clear vision with regard to Pakistan's present situation and its role as a major player in shaping the future of its neighboring country, Afghanistan, with the aim of founding peace and stability in the Central Asia region, the Editor-in-Chief of the Yemen Times interviewed Pakistan's Ambassador to Yemen, who on his part responded to a number of questions raised by the paper. The following interview gives Pakistan's regional and international perception of the whole situation in addition to clarifying the relations between Pakistan and Yemen and also means and ways of promoting them.

Q: How do you assess the results thus far of the US-led and Pakistansupported strikes against Afghanistan?

A: Let me first say that there may have been assumptions. However, anybody who knows anything about Afghan history will admit that Afghanistan is not a piece of cheese. Rather it is a labyrinth with a minotaur lurking at every turn. Having said that, it is clear that Afghan people are tired of warfare and want peace. There is difficulty in achieving this objective because Afghanistan is fractured at present. Nonetheless, these are extraordinary circumstances and it is quite possible that the pressure may get the kind of coalition that the international community has been calling for. The neighbors and other important powers should help facilitate this process. But in the ultimate analysis, it is the Afghan people who will have to work for national reconciliation. It is something which can only be done by the Afghans them-

Nothing can be propped up from outside. If efforts are made to impose one group or another in Afghanistan, as we have said, it will not bring peace to Afghanistan. Some observers had this assumption in the past that the Taliban were propped up by Pakistan. Now everybody can see the fallacy of that assertion. This is for the Afghans, first and foremost, to work out to bring about a broad-based government.


This also happened earlier, when in 1992, under pressure of circumstances, they agreed to a political arrangement. The Afghans themselves were able to put together some accords. Regrettably, later these accords were not honored. At present also there are a number of processes simultaneously taking place, and we hope for their success and a positive outcome.

Q: Despite Pakistan's clear call for a halt of the strikes during the holy month of Ramadan, the USA pledged to continue. Does Pakistan intend to go on supporting the USA in its strikes against Afghans even during Ramadan?

A: We have made our position clear, and that is done at the level of the Head of State. Our President's statement on this account is very clear - that there should be no operations during the month of Ramadan, because that would certainly cause anxiety and aggravate sentiments of Muslims, not only in Pakistan but throughout the Islamic world. The sanctity of the holy month of Ramadan is observed throughout the Islamic world. Therefore, we would emphasize that the sentiments with regard to the holy month of Ramadan should be respectant.

Q: How can the Pakistani government cope with the mounting anger of the Pakistani public due to the

A: Our government's decision to support the international anti-terror campaign was based on principles. President Musharraf before taking this bold and wise decision extensively consulted all cross-sections of people, intellectuals and religious leaders, because of the domestic sentiments opposed to the requirements of action in Afghanistan against the terrorists. The government has taken a considerable stance which had the support of the vast majority of the people. The objectives of the US-led strikes are to target the terrorist camps inside Afghanistan and those who are harboring them. However, the killing of innocent people during this campaign is highly regrettable and mounting pressure in Pakistan as well as in other Islamic countries, which is certainly a cause of concern for us as well. Since the majority of the people in Pakistan supported the government's decision, the government is fully in control of the situation in Pakistan.

Q: It has been reported that the Pakistani government failed to stop thousands of Pakistanis crossing the borders to fight with the Taliban. What is the impact of this on Pakistan-US relations?

A: Pakistan's position is very clear on this. We would not want any Pakistani to be going inside Afghanistan. We have also asked the Afghan government and the Taliban leadership that they should not have any Pakistani as part of their military efforts or part of their forces, and they should not have them in their training bases etc. This is not the position we have taken now, this is a position that we had taken quite some time ago and we have been emphasizing this position after the adoption of Resolution 1267, which is almost one and half years old now. So that position continues to remain the same and we maintain it.

Q: Why did Pakistan stop giving visas to Yemenis? Is this out of fear that some Arab Afghans in Yemen could travel to Pakistan in an attempt to join the thousands to fight with Taliban?

A: Pakistan's government has not stopped issuing visas to Yemen nationals. Study and visit visas are being issued after fulfillment of procedural formalities. All genuine businessmen who intend to visit Pakistan are also being issued visas after production of necessary business documents.





Afghanistan vs. Terrorism of Globalization

he September 11 attacks New York and Washington DC were just horrible humanitarian atrocities. The whole world and the Arab and Islamic world in particular condemned these actions

which killed many innocent civilians including Muslims. Such attacks and their consequences, that is the formation of a global coalition to fight terrorism, the mobilization of military forces in an unprecedented manner and the continued brutal attacks against Afghanistan, go way beyond simply re-drawing international map. Now, it seems that the US-led war against the socalled terrorism



Currently, Israel cannot justify its strike against Hizbulah as, if it has been able to do so, it should have stroked during the time of the presence of its forces in Southern Lebanon. The existence of Hizbulah is of prime ing Islamic movements at the intellectual and political levels around the Islamic world.

Commenting on September 11 attacks, al-Hakimi said that hastiness in accusing Osama bin Laden and al-Qaeda network of being responsible of carrying out the attacks was a surprise move since all the participants in these actions died in the crashes. He adds that the US administration has no definite proof against him. Furthermore, he insists on the fact that a wide portion of Muslims still believe that Osama bin Laden does not have the capability to carry out operations of that scale which require sophisticated technology, intelligence, planning and execution capacities. So, regardless of who is the responsible of September 11 attacks, American national interests dictate the US administration to carry out serious and huge investigations in order to know the perpetrators of these attacks. Abdullah Salaam al-Hakimi does not believe that the international events following the September 11 attacks are in any way related to a war of religions or a crusade, as some people described it. The main reason is that the modern world cannot accept religious or ethnic conflicts such as those which took place in the Middle Age. The whole world supports now peaceful coexistence, cooperation and complementarity for the sake of humanity as a whole without any discrimination or prejudice. 

Plans to Improve Economic Performance in the Wake of September 11 Attacks

he Yemeni government is currently assessing the impact of September 11 attacks on Yemeni economy by launching new economic policies aimed at reduce the negative consequences of the attacks on New York and Washington as well as the current war against Afghanistan. Essentially, these two events caused a drop in oil prices at the international markets, the decline in investment flows, and a sharp decrease of tourism in Yemen.

Undoubtedly, one of the most important issue, which affects the economy of the Republic of Yemen, is the fact that there will be a rise in air and sea transportation charges. These are due to the increase of insurance charges in light of some reports describing Yemen as one of the unsafest countries in the

Middle East. According to official Europe and the United States. sources, the Yemeni government will freeze some of the big development projects dependent on oil revenues and will work out on new promotional plans to revive the tourism sector.

The overall losses incurred in Yemen since 11 September attacks are estimated at over US\$ 3 billion in the oil, tourism, services and investments sectors. Despite the effort exerted by the Yemeni government to diversify its revenues, 95% of the budget still depends on oil revenues.

As a part of new solutions proposed by Yemen Airways (Yemenia) to tackle the disastrous consequences of the attacks on WTC and the Pentagon, the airline is to expand its operation lines to cope with the rise in number of passengers to and from Yemen. Furthermore, Yemenia is planning to operate flights, as of the beginning of January 2002, to Kuala Lumpur and Jakarta where 5 million Yemenis live. In the wake of September 11 attacks, Yemenia Airways had to cancel contracts to transport 60,000 tourists from

New Tourism Promotion Plans

The Tourism Promotion Board has prepared an urgent plan totaling YR 130 million to reduce the decline in tourism revenues. The plan principally aims at putting an end to kidnappings of foreign tourists in Yemen and adopting new policies which deal with tourist markets and encourage a stronger presence in the markets of the Gulf countries and Southeast Asia. In addition, the Cabinet approved the tourism promotion plan which includes using Arabic and international satellite channels in order to attract more tourists in Yemen. The successful achievement of the new tourism plan's goals will depend on winning the confidence of tourists to come to Yemen and visit its unique historical monuments and antiquities.

Concerning the security measures, the plan will provide the Tourism Police modern means of transportation as well as re-deploying them at the main tourist attractions. For this end, YR 20 million have been allocated by the government in addition to another YR 5 million earmarked to support the personnel of the tourism police and give them up-to-date equipment.


According to some sources at the Tourism Promotion Board, the plan relies on two priorities: first, to raise the citizens' awareness of the importance of tourism as an economic source; second, to work for activating the touristic installations in a drive to counter the recession effect in the tourism sector.

Activating Domestic Tourism

The tourism plan focuses on activating seasonal domestic tourism and popular festivals as well in cities, that attracts the majority of Yemeni tourists, like Husainyyah, Seyoun, Aden, Sana'a, Mukala, Hudaidah, and others.

It is clear that activating tourism in

Yemen requires a strategic plan oriented towards its expansion. Likewise, reforming the economic situation and attracting a large number of investors in the tourism sector require efficient policies that can efficiently promote the country and increase therefore the flow of tourists in Yemen. Ultimately, the Yemeni economy requires a continued review of its performance in various activities, rather than emergency remedies for the negative consequences of September 11 attacks as partial plans always face hassles upon implementa-

eviewing sea navigation lines is of strategic importance in an attempt to activate Yemen's role in the World Trade Organization (WTO). The organization will in turn entails a new marketing policy in accordance with the geographical and strategic location of Yemen overlooking the Al-Mandab Strait which controls the international trade passageways. This strategic location contributed very much in improving the Yemeni trade balance with other parts of the world and the neighboring countries. Consequently, a working team from the Ministry of Transportation was convened to amend surveys and preparing special maps dealing with the international navigation lines in the southern parts of the Red Sea and Aden Gulf in order to generate a clearer system dividing the sea roads and locating them for vessels. This will

will enhance Yemen's' role in international trade. Sources said in the Transportation Ministry that Yemen will offer to the

International Navigation Organization proposals concerning the location of the new lines under the name of these countries: Yemen, Djibouti and Eritrea. Sources are expecting the new navigation lines to pass through western crossing points located in the southern parts of the Red Sea. This new line will provide safety by reducing the risk of sea collisions and

controlling the current navigation lines, particularly around the dangerous areas of Hunish archipelagos located in the Red Sea. The British company, Guard Line Service, completed the marine surveys in the southern parts of the Red Sea. It also prepared the necessary maps for the future passing vessels. The British company used up-to-date materials to

conduct the sea surveys. Navigation experts said that, by reconsidering the international navigation lines, Yemen together with other countries like Djibouti and Eritrea will achieve its economic objectives. They added that the most important issue should be the protection of the sea from pollution caused by ship collisions and avoiding the dangers of the huge oil tankers.

The new sea lines will consolidate the trade relations between Yemen and the adjacent countries. It is in Yemen's interest to re-organize sea traffic within a strategic policy which will protect the environment of the Red Sea and Aden gulf and attract foreign capital to be injected in the fish industry. These investments will in turn enable the industry to establish facilities able to export their output.

By this mean, the government expresses its eagerness to increase its revenues from exports not related with the hydrocarbon sector.

hat has come to be tragic consequence of their own choosing, it appears that the fate of Taliban in Afghanistan, especially in the Holy Month of Ramadhan, requires us as Moslems to reevaluate the tragic aftermath of the fateful day of September 11, 2001 and to explore what can be learned from the pitiful tragic finale for Taliban that the Afghan crisis seems to have arrived

It is a relief that there are some people dedicated to disseminate reports and views that are actually not opinion or manipulated information by corporations, like the New York Times or more particularly CNN, in fact the entire American press. I read in an article that US is engaged in a worldwide effort to promote US views. They are planning to set up some Arab media with US influences. Even the Pentagon has made a contract with a public relations company to deal with the public opinion. They want to appear as if they are doing something legitimate. Please do not yield to western pressure and do make more editorials, reports and articles unveiling the real motives and giving a comprehensive picture of the events.

I am opposed to the US, so what? To accuse somebody of being opposed to US actions has some contextual problems. In the first place, what does the person mean by "you oppose to US?" It is an accusation without arguments since it only expresses superfluous emotions rather than having a real cause. 

Roads in Taiz in Bad Shape

he majority of the roads in Taiz have been imperfectly built and, therefore, are in the process of completely falling apart. This deterioration is criticized by the President of the Republic. Millions of dollars are spent by the government in paving these roads instead of asphalting them. Under the absence of law to protect and maintain roads, no sense of attention is paid at all. As a result, these roads are exposed to heavy damage and destruction. So, the people in charge should be punished or at least be interrogated due to their carelessness.

Roads in Taiz

Roads in Taiz are a clear proof of the reigning corruption, inattention, and absence of proper planning. As a consequence, narrow streets are so hastily constructed that holes and cracks appear very rapidly. We are joking about our streets hasty completion. The reasons behind such carelessness are the lack of proper implementation and other causes including floods coming from Saber Mountain which inundate



problem has become more alarming as there is no draining channels to evacuate water. Actually, there is not even any coordination between the service offices and the bodies concerned.

Although some projects are successfully completed, other contractors or people come and destroy what was done by digging and refill-

ing up holes in the streets again and again. The result is destruction and nothing else.

Another cause can be explain such careless work: centralization. This has greatly affected our offices and administrations in the governorate. Indeed, the majority of road projects is financed directly by the main office in the Ministry Public Works itself, and this without giving any notice to Public Works Office or Roads Authority in the city. We were really shocked to learn that the construction of some roads and

streets are decided on a central level rather than locally. When these roads present huge damages, the people in charge in Taiz argue that repair is not their business but rather Public Works Office or Roads Authority's responsibility. Consequently, the roads construction is the responsibility of the Ministry and Public Works Office but its task is restricted only to repair minor

things, such as water pipes, telephone lines and so on.

Road Contractors

Specific construction companies, with which the Ministry of the Public Works makes legal contracts, are entitled to build roads. Regrettably, these companies do not have a great experience or required skills to set up the proper planning structure. In this respect, the Governor of the city criticized these companies by saying that they are incapable to build roads and therefore cannot obey to high international stan-



dards. Sana'a-Taiz road, for example, was completed by a skillful Chinese company. Till now, the road is still strong and appears not be affected by external factors. More than 30 years after its completion, we have not noticed any changes or maintenance works, while any street close to the southern Ring Road in Taiz shows signs of deterioration. This a clear evidence of a lack of maintenance and corruption among our local construction companies. Moreover, the majority of streets in Taiz are either undulating or full of cracks.

The General Manager of Roads and Bridges Corporation, Engineer Naser Al-Haikani, attributes the roads deterioration to the two sides, that is the government and the contractors. On one hand, the government sketches plans and asks local or foreign companies to start the construction. On the other hand, the construction phase comes and is always accompanied by misconceptions and failures. Among these are the following:

- Starting new projects which are not included in the framework of previous plans and are launched at the expense f other projects.

- Negligence and carelessness in the allocation of the financial budget.

- Hasty estimation of projects without enabling the building contractors to gain skills in the construction field by setting up practical experiences and other relevant training field surveys such as working force, equipment and financial support to provide them with the essential needs as quickly as possible.

The Engineer Khaled thought that rifts in the streets are a consequence of water leaking under the asphalted areas, as there is no protective layers under the asphalt. So, based on the observations made by the engineers in the city, the construction companies are held accountable for such damages and destructions.

The Projects Manager, Engineer Easa Al-Qubati, points out that the main cause to our street destruction is not only the excessive loads of vehicles but also the absence of supervision from the concerned bodies. This leads to the misuse of basic infrastructures, such as water draining structure, telephone and electricity cables, while asphalting

main streets without any consideration for the damage caused to the sub-levels of main streets.

Southern Road Ring is a Clear Evidence of Negligence

The Ring Road in Taiz is a clear evidence of carelessness and imperfect construction of the road. The road was actually completed in two phases, the first inaugurated in 1993 and the second in 19996. It immediately reduced traffic jams but was partially damaged only a few months after its inauguration. The Engineer Easa Al-Qubati said that Saba Contracting Company followed the standards set by the Ministry of the Public Works and that engineers from the Ministry



closely supervised the Ring Road construction. The main causes for such damage can be traced in the overflow of water in the road structure and in the broken pipes located beside. In short, the excessive loads of trucks and heavy rain resulted in the damage at the street edges.

Roads in the Villages

In Taiz, there is another alarming issue: the roads to the surrounding villages. The building process is often randomly carried out without proper planning. For example, Shara'ab road is a clear manifestation of such carelessness. These roads are repaired several times in a year but the same damages happen

again and again. The Manager of Roads and Bridges clearly points out that the main cause of such snail-like projects is the unavailability of necessary equipments to successfully build such road projects and the lack of sufficient financial support. But the question which comes out is what are the solutions?

The topography of the city itself is a challenge and renders inadequate thin layers of asphalt. It necessitates instead a thick layer and a proper planning. Successful projects can be found when sub-levels of streets are paved some with flat stones. Perhaps, this is the best way to protect the city streets from being damaged by washouts.







Health Problems in Yemen & Their Population Dimensions

hree main factors are contributing to population growth in Yemen, that is rapidly rising birthrate, decreasing death rate, and emigration. The population growth rate in Yemen reached 3.1% in the 1980s and 3.7% between 1988 and 1994. The overall fertility rate, during that period, was 7.7% per woman according to demographic surveys conducted in Yemen for Mother and Child Hygiene and as mentioned in the population census carried in 1994. In comparison with the more advanced countries, fertility rate in Yemen appears to be one of the highest rates in the world.

Early marriages among the youths, rapid delivery, improper use of contraceptives, undesirable traditions prevailing in the country, preference of males over females, along with other factors are the main causes of backwardness of any country. We can say that, in the light of the recent changes in Yemen, the country has entered the second phase of demographic evolution which is characterized by the relative stability of fertility rates and the fall of mortality rates by the reduction of epidemics, malnutrition, contagious and children diseases, such as diarrhea and respiratory system troubles.

Clearly, the relative improvement of medical and preventive services, the high increase of health awareness on the importance of pure water and immunization all have led to the gradual decrease of mortality rates.

Consequently, according to the demographic survey for Mother and Child Hygiene conducted in 1991 and 1992, the mortality rates have sharply dropped since the 1970s. It was at 194 in the beginnings of 1970s before diminishing to 185 in the midst of 1970s. At the beginnings of the 1980s, it reached 129 before dropping to 83 at the beginnings of 1990s. The number has fell to 81 according to the 1994

The high increase of the population is the result of the growing gap between death and birth rates which can create serious problems. Demographic explosion, which needs resources, can further strain the already limited resources and weak human potentials.

Population Problem

The economic conditions of Yemeni population are getting worse. Indeed, one could easily notice that the number of people below the poverty line has significantly increased and unemployment has been on the rise, which is a direct correlation of the economic

Each year, we can see a new list of food supplies for which prices are higher than those of the previous year. The list is very different from the previous in terms of price increase of basic goods. Despite permanent attempts to ease up the situation by using treasury bonds and encouraging privatization, our currency convertibility has not stopped deteriorating.

Although reasonable improvements in health conditions have been noticed in Yemen over the last two decades, the health sector is still facing huge challenges. These include a persistent high fertility rate of 3.7% per woman and a chronic shortage of health services with a ratio of 1 doctor per 4,348 inhabitants.

These problems are reflected in the alarming health indicators which recently revealed that the maternal mortality rate is between 80 and 100 per 1,000 live births while the infant mortality rates are 78.8 per 1,000. This makes them among the highest rates in the world, mainly because of complications during pregnancy, child birth and malnutrition related diseases, lack of hygiene, lack of sanitation and safe

The health sector is facing many pressing issues, among them how to reach rural populations and how to solve the organizational and management prob-

Only 55% of the population has access to medical facilities, while in the meantime public health services in many rural areas are almost non-exis-

Among the obstacles, which are slowing down the efforts made by the Ministry of Health, the growing sewage and sanitation problems found in the major cities are the most alarming. Inadequate sewage treatment facilities result in the outbreak of diseases, such as malaria and diarrhea, in the urban areas. Similarly, a clean water supply has become less available in urban concentrations because it virtually impossible to further explore ground waters.

International assistance agencies and donor countries have been heavy contributors to the health sector, especially in sponsoring nationwide immunization campaigns and disease control campaigns. But too much aid is given for management upgrading and direct medical assistance, which so far has not been as successful as expected.

The low capital investments are mainly located in the society's low-income segment which has a low purchasing power. As a result, the medical companies providing services to this kind of patients make relatively low profit

In contrast, the higher income segment of the society seeks very expensive medication abroad for even simple illnesses which can be cured locally. There is not a single world-class private hospital in the whole country. A well-organized and fully-equipped hospital run by an international medical company would be a prime investment able of reaping huge profits. The opportunity is there and, in this end, the government should provide incentives and permits. The oil companies, embassies and international companies make their employees travel abroad for simple problems due to the absence of a service they can trust.

As a conclusion, Yemen is in great need for good health services. We have one of the lowest standards in health and medical care in the world. The economic condition of the country is one of the main obstacles for having health insurance and medical care provided by the state. In this case, the best and easiest alternative is to establish private institutions that can provide health care for the public. Prices may be high, but with more investment, there will be competition. And, with more competition, there will be better services and lower prices. Health care must be taken seriously and should be one of the most important focal points of the government's investment program. If we want a better nation, we ought to make it a healthier nation. For that to happen, the next step should be investment in health services.

Second Round of Sixth Campaign for Polio Eradication in Yemen Successfully Completed

ince 1996, the Republic of Yemen has been achieving gradual success in implementing its health strategy centered on eradication of child polio through six national campaigns. This will allow Yemen to qualify for a distinctive position among the East-Mediterranean region. Such achievement is also of great value for the children of Yemen, the country's next generation.

The current sixth national campaign is of great significance as it is the last and final national campaign to eradicate child polio in Yemen. By the end of this campaign, our country will be qualified to obtain the international certificate stating that Yemen is clear from child polio.

Our country has therefore been making great efforts in providing the required personnel, technical and financial capacities in order to make this campaign a success. Everybody, in all official and social institutions as well as in

the concerned international organizations, has been performing their utmost to make sure that child polio will forever be eradicated in Yemen and to make the country among those free from this disease.

The World Health Organization (WHO) has played a key role in eradicating child polio in our country. The Representative of the WHO in Yemen praised our country's performance, especially as it was able to eradicate child polio within the time frame previously set. He added that no child polio cases were reported in the past. three years, which indicates the success of Yemen's anti-child polio cam-

He also praised the strategy adopted since 1996 and said that, in the first campaign, 30% of the targeted children were vaccinated. But, due to the national campaigns, the number of vaccination jumped to 72% among children aged 1 or below.

The Folklore Dances in Lahj

very Yemeni folk dance has its own flavor and taste. Even if they seem to be similar to one another, the different kinds of dance prospered and flourished in Aden and other regions such as Lahj. The many foreign communities that settled in Aden helped contribute to the variety of dances in this beautiful city. It is said that some of the folk dances are a mixture of Indian, Somali and other flavors. Despite the modern aspects of technology, all folk dances are still performed in the company of primitive instruments such as drums and pipes

In Al-Maharah, there are some dances that are performed by a single dancer and others which are performed by more than one. Similar dances are performed elsewhere in the neighborhood, but their names are different

There are many dances in which men and women dance together to the beat of drums, especially on happy occasions such as wedding ceremonies.

All kinds of dance in Yemen seem to be a reflection of the day-to-day life or the surroundings. This may explain the secret of the continuation of these kinds of dances until the present time. In this respect, we will talk about different dances in Lahj. The city of Lahj has a special atmosphere. It is characterized by love and peace, with its lush meadows and attractive landscapes. This city is famous for its palm trees and fragrant flowers such as Arabian jasmine and skew pipes. This strange beauty makes the city a tourist spot for all visitors. Al-Husieni, the famous botanical garden in the city, is famous for fruit production, and it is the place where its lovers sing the sweetest songs because of this fascinating wadi.

Undoubtedly, Lahj has still preserved rich folkloric heritage, and among its heritage are folkloric dances which have been preserved and handed down from generation to generation. In this respect, Lahj has diverse folkloric dances. Among these are:

- Askari dance is performed by two men during marriage ceremonies. Different traditional music instruments are still played, such as drums (Tabl). Table, as it is called, or Tasa which is put around the drummer's neck and beaten by two special sticks called bamboos (Khaizaran), which have a resonant sound, together with a very old booming musical instrument called

drummed by one stick. This kind of dance is performed during wedding ceremonies.

- The Indian dance is characterized by bravery and performed by two men. Each one carries a sword in his hand. The two dancers compete with each

- Al-Markah dance is a popular dance performed by two women only. This dance is characterized by slow ground music. Women dancers, in this case, have to wear the most beautiful clothes they have. A woman stretches her right leg and hits on the ground in accordance with drum beats.

- Al-Rakla Dance was popular in the past and began to disappear in a number of regions in the south.



Commemorating the Life of **Bakathir**

egrettably, we forget our artists the moment they pass away; they are never again to be remembered. The 10th of November makes us remember the passing of one of the legendary writers of Yemeni literature in 1959; that is Ali Ahmed Bakathir. The famous Yemeni Bakathir passed away with no clamor after a long suffering, most probably from the trauma of the 1967 defeat of Arabs by Israel. Bakathir was born in Indonesia in 1915 and then returned to Hadramaut when he was 8 years old. He studied Islamic theology and Arabic language in Sayoun and started composing poetry while he was still very young. He was greatly influenced by some Arab poets like Ahmed Shuqi, Hafiz Ibrahim and Khalil Matran.

While Bakathir was young he worked in teaching and published "al-Tahthib" magazine. After the death of his beloved wife, Bakathir lived most of his life in Ethiopia and Aden, and then stayed in Hijaz (Saudi Arabia), where he wrote a lyrical social play and composed many religious poems. In 1934 he left Saudi Arabia for Egypt and settled there to study English literature. Bakathir worked as an English teacher for 14 years at al-Rashad in Mansura,

Bakathir excelled during his stay in Egypt. He wrote his first work challenging his professor at the Department of English Literature in Cairo, as the latter accused the Arabic language of being inflexible. Thereafter, Bakathir translated the famous work of Shakespeare's

"Romeo & Juliet." Bakathir highlighted the idea of pan-Arabism in his works, particularly emphasizing the Palestinian cause. He embodied this idea in his plays "The Chosen People of God," " The New Chylock," "Secret of Ruler," the and "Shahrazad's Secret." All of the plays written by Bakathir are critical of the situation of Arab states, particularly with regard to the Arab-Israeli conflict.

Similarly, Bakathir wrote historical plays such as " Wa Islamah" and the "The Red Revolutionist," which triggered hatred against Bakathir from

Communists in Egypt; they wrote many articles criticizing him in Egyptian newspapers. Bakathir loved his hometown Hadramaut very much; thus, he returned there in 1998 and settled there as well. Shortly after settling in Hadramout, Bakathir went back to Cairo and decided to stay there, despite invitations to run newspapers and cultural centers in countries such as Kuwait and Lebanon

Bakathir is one of the most prominent Arab playwrites of the 20th century. He was awarded many medals, including the State Prize of Egypt for his play "Harot and Marot," as well as an exclusive medal from the late Jamal Abdulnasir of Egypt in 1967.

Now, 32 years have passed since the death of Bakathir, and a new genera-



tion has little knowledge about Bakathir or his literature, except for "Wa Islamah," which is included in basic education textbooks, while Bakathir's publications are virtually non-existent in the university curricula. As Bakathir suffered from negligence during his lifetime, his writings also are neglected after his death. Moreover, the death memorial of Bakathir passed away without any notice from the Ministry of Culture, authors or even cultural foundations. Nothing proves our love or respect to this person except the conversion of his house in Hadramaut into an office for the Author Union there. Ultimately, we hope that the concerned authorities will work together to commemorate Bakathir. Would that happen?

Yemeni Intellectuals in History

established Islamic had al-Madinah Munawarah as its capital, more attention was paid to this small, but important city which after a short time became a hearthstone for so many people. Yemen was also affected by the enlightenment coming from this city, before the capital of the Islamic state was shifted to Damascus, Baghdad and then to Cairo.

The far distance between Yemen and the capital of the Islamic caliphate had its effects on Yemen which was away from attracting the attention of the Arabs. For along time Yemen seemed to be unable to produce a great intellectual, or scientific, etc.., work. However, this idea about Yemen and Yemenis was changed in the hands of a number of Yemeni immigrants who

lived in the Arab capital that was receiving more attention. Some of these people are Amaarah, Abdulmajid b. Abdulbaqi, etc. who introduced Yemen to the others. During the Crusade and other wars that were waged from time to time some Arab intellectuals fled their countries to Yemen. These also helped enhanced Yemen's existence by a number of their works. Some of these intellectuals are al-Judhri, Ibn Hajar al-Asqalani, Ibn Qalafis, etc. In the modern time there were Mohebaddin al-Khatib, Jawad Ali, and others. Such people worked as a bridge among the Arab civilizations and cultures.

There are other factors that helped limiting Yemeni intellectual works to be known. Among those factors are the isolation of the country that was imposed by some of the rulers. There was a time at which all intellectuals

were dragged to jails, beaten up and even killed.

One of the great times of Yemeni enlightenment was during the Rasolids' regime which lasted from the 7th century until the end of the 9th century. During the three centuries a cluster of intellectuals, scientists and artists were produced. Unfortunately, the collapse of the Rasolids' state led to the loss of many books that were kept in huge libraries, especially after the Ottoman invasion of Yemen.

During the 12th and 13th centuries a number of Yemeni renewers came to being. These include al-Jalal, al-Muqbli and Mohammed b. Ibrahim al-Wazir. In the 19th century there were al-Amir, al-Shawkani and al-Amrani. All of these people and many others played a great role to show Yemeni as



Our Campus: Retrospect and Prospect

Mohammad Al-Kamali is a distinguished scholar and an astute administrator of Sana'a University. He has a diversified and thorough experience. In his capacity as the Vice Dean of the Faculty of Arts, Sana'a University, he has made numerous contributions for the enrichment of the faculty. This is a good augury for the Faculty of Education in Al-Mahweet to have Dr. Al-Kamali as the new Dean. In order to get an overview of his first impressions about his current assignment and to discover the outlines of his plans for inculcating a vibrant spirit of innovation into the current educational scenario in Al-Mahweet, Dr. Ramakanta Sahu conducted an interview with him. The following are some excerpts.

RKS: What are your impressions after taking over the reins of a remote college like Faculty of Education, Al-Mahweet?

MA: The existing infrastructure of the College in relation with the steady increase in the enrollment of students is inadequate to accommodate the volume of students. It is urgent to expand the College's facilities to meet the demand of classrooms whose scarcity has become an acute problem.

RKS: What is your assessment of the level of students and the academic atmosphere in the College?

MA: It is gratifying to note that the members of the Faculty, especially the Associate Professors and Professors, are highly accomplished in their respective academic fields. As far as students are concerned, I have observed that a majority of them are


committed to hard work and are competing with each other in a healthy

RKS: In your opinion, what are some of the major problems faced by the College and the student commu-

MA: The College is confronted with numerous weaknesses which prevents it from a sustainable development. As I have said earlier, inadequacy of infrastructure is the first and foremost. Second, and nonetheless important, is scarcity of a sufficient number of academic staff holding the required specializations. As a result, we are depending on visiting scholars to teach these subjects, which undoubtedly hampers the academic standards of teaching and learning in the College.

RKS: What are your plans for revitalizing the academic atmosphere in the College?

MA: There are several issues which have to be addressed effectively and with great attention. My first priority area is to streamline the administrative apparatus and the academic environment in the College in order to make them more accountable. We have begun work in this direction by setting up various committees dealing with specific tasks and responsibilities. This first step will be followed by the preparation and production of quality textbooks which will keep sight of the current expansion in the frontiers of knowledge. Appropriate measures will subsequently be adopted to promote the level of the students' academic performance. Besides, I am planning to launch a well-orchestrated program aimed at encouraging research activities among the members of the Faculty.



RKS: Any words of advice you would like to convey to the students? MA: I have a lot to say to my dear students. The most essential thing which I expect from them is regular attendance to all lectures in the College. They should develop their level of self-confidence and relentlessly work towards increasing their knowledge of academic and other related issues. They should develop a critical frame of mind to conduct high quality research on various educational and social problems. Moreover, they need to be more strongly involved and participative in the various extracurricular activities organized by the College. I expect them to have a closer interaction with teachers and be worthy ambassadors of our traditional value system, both inside and outside the campus. This way they could be living examples that would emulate others.

RKS: Thanks a lot for your precious opinion. I hope and am sure that our student community as well others would benefit from your valuable pieces of advice.

MA: Thanks to Yemen Times and to you for giving me this opportunity to share my views with you.

A Letter to the Teachers of English - III

Use the Blackboard Effectively

Dear Teachers.

It will be naive if I think that you are not using your blackboard in your English classes. But, I am worried about those among you who either overuse or do not use enough the blackboard. To most of you, I am aware that the blackboard is the only support easily available. I am also aware that some of you work in situations where a good blackboard is just a luxury. But when it is available, you should learn to use it

Using efficiently the blackboard is an art. I have seen some of my trainees not being able to write properly on the blackboard, while some others have been blessed with beautiful hands. I have also noticed that many teachers scribble on the blackboard in such a way that their students cannot copy what they write. You must be patient

when you write and keep your slowest learner in mind. Remember that you are not writing to satisfy yourselves, but to help your students to learn from what you know and write. So write neatly and legibly on the board. Your handwriting does not need to be beautiful or nicely shaped but rather neat and legi-

The blackboard is used not only for writing but also for drawing figures as an illustration for certain grammatical or syntax-related items, tables, pictures, diagrams, or maps while teaching. Surely, not all of us are experts in drawing but with constant practice it is not impossible to draw nicely. Age should also not be a factor preventing you from learning to write neatly. Some of my colleagues learned to write the italic script at a very late age. The italic script is indeed one of the ways of writing and

differs from the commonly used cursive writing. Italic script is generally recommended for English classes because it presents the three necessary qualities of handwriting: neatness, legibility, and nice shape. In fact, special wide nibs for practicing italic writing are available in the market. A cheaper alternative is a bamboo pen that can be easily set up. Take a small and thin bamboo stick. Sharpen one of its ends to make it niblike and cut the nib a bit flat. Soak it into ink and write. You will have neat and nicely shaped handwriting. You can also make the end of a chalk a bit flatter and try writing on the blackboard. Good luck! More about blackboard writing in my next letters.

slavery. They work like donkeys and they have a wretched life in Yemeni society.



This lower class works in different inferior places, and they are exploited by the authorities and the political parties during elections to gain their votes for the benefit of a specific party. Now the area has been fenced off by the police. Sources in the Secretariat said that although the Akhdam didn't refuse to be leave the place, the possibility of compensating them is a weak promise; their friends were also promised to be

compensated, but when they left the place they found nothing but streets to reside in and ask for help. One of them, Aesh, said that he lost more than his livestock due to the recent incidents which occurred last Saturday from 4 a.m. until 8 p.m. This critical issue should be treated rationally, and a sense of respecting the freedoms of human rights should be carefully considered. Above all, we are in dire need of national action and strong political will to save this inferior class, the class of Akhdam.



Population Fund (UNFPA) and the National Population Council organized last week a press conference for marking the release of a report on the status of population in Yemen and around the globe for the year 2001 entitled "Population and Environmental Changes."

Mutahar Zabarah, the Assistant Secretary of the National Population Council, said the population growth that took place in the second half of the 20th century at the international level, and in the Third World in particular, led to high demand for natural resources, so as to cause the debilitation of water resources, food and energy. Concerning the status of the Republic of Yemen, Zabarah said that Yemen is part of the world and thus has greatly been influenced by the economic, social and environmental changes resulting from the rapid and huge population growth and its negative consequences. The outcomes of this problem will certainly affect the future of our rising generation, as the population of the Republic of Yemen has risen from 5 million inhabitants in 1960 to more than 20 million inhabitants presently. The annual population growth rate as reported for the mid-90s of the last century totaled 3.7% per annum, which is one of the highest growth rates in the world, despite the fact that this rate has decreased within the last few years. One of the most negative consequences of the rapid population growth in the area of the environment is that the tremendous population growth coincides with a movement of population from the rural areas to the major cities in a very random manner. The internal immigration from the countryside to cities is an issue of major concerns, as it negatively affects the agricultural production in rural areas in ways that add further burdens on the services provided in cities, particularly if the necessary potentials are lacking in the cities. Mr. Zabarah added that the available studies pertaining to population and environment in the Republic of Yemen utterly confirm that the population growth has direct effects on the available resources. This is clear with regard to water resources, arable lands, and the green areas and wildlife which have greatly damaged in unprecedented way, due to high demand and misuse of these resources by the population. These irresponsible practices should sound an alarming bell in Yemen. For instance, the misuse of the underground water, especially in Sana'a, Taiz and Sa'adah, has caused a real disaster in these areas. Studies reveal that each Yemeni's share of water is continually decreasing as a result of the growing population. Thus, based on some expectations pertaining to the average population growth, the share of each inhabitant will decease from 138 cubic meters of underground water per capita to nearly 86 cubic meters in

According to Mutahar Zabarah, the negative consequences of population growth and movement to cities will not merely affect water resources, but also the environment in general, represented by the excessive use of chemical substances for agriculture, wastewater disposal and the misuse of natural resources by people. Mr. Mutahar Zabarah concluded his remarks by stressing that this occasion marks an anniversary for all of us, so as to be aware and competent in tackling the different dangers threatening our existence as humans. Zabarah maintained that striking a balance between the growth of population and environment will not become a reality without the mobilizing efforts of all related bodies, particularly with regard to raising public awareness, which can play a major role in rationalizing our practices harmful to environment.



by the constitution and divine jurisprudence. We want this problem to be known by the Minister of Human Rights, Dr. Waheeba Farae, and the diverse human rights organizations present in Yemen.

For a long time and up to this moment, Akhdam have been known as the black people in Yemen, particularly those who move from one place to another searching for shelter. Akhdam have diverse rituals, but their permanent ritual is misery, torture and The Sheikh of Akhdam in Bab Al-Yemen, Shuaee, said more than 5000 people and around 50 families reside in the place, distributed in different houses, such as slums mud houses, rundown parts and other houses made from thatches. He demanded that the Minister of Human Rights interfere to stop such acts since they are Yemeni citizens. "Why do such infringements befall us for the simplest human criteria?" he added. Ambassador of Pakistan to the YT...

O: Millions of Afghan refugees are flowing into Pakistan. Is the US providing sufficient financial assistance and humanitarian relief to cope with this disaster?

A: The Afghan refugees problem is of great concern for Pakistan. We already have about three million Afghan refugees in Pakistan. Hundreds of thousands of refugees want to cross over into Pakistan, Our dilemma is that of how to accommodate more. Pakistan in this regard has been dealing with the UNHCR, the United States and other countries of the world to help Pakistan in dealing with this problem of gigantic magnitude. You can compare this to when you think of a country like Australia not prepared to accept even two hundred refugees, then how can it be expected from a country like Pakistan to accommodate refugees over and above three million already in Pakistan? Our point of view has always been that refugee camps should be set-up across the border in Afghanistan and all assistance to the refugees must be given over there so that the people go back to Afghanistan instead of settling and becoming burden on Pakistan's already over-stretched economy of 14 million people. We are still not satisfied with the magnitude of assistance being provided by the United Nations and the international community and hope that this problem of enormous magnitude and consequences would be shared by all, including the United

O: Pakistan does not consider Kashmiri Muslim fighters to be terrorists, while the USA and India do. Do you feel that the USA is adopting a double standard in this regard?

A: The Kashmir issue stems from the incomplete agenda of partition of the Indo-Pak subcontinent in 1047. The partition plan envisages that the residents of the Indian Principalities would decide whether to become part of India or Pakistan. However, in the case of Jammu and Kashmir, this principle was treacherously violated by the Indian rulers and the Kashmiris were not allowed to exercise their option. This was the beginning of the struggle of the Kashmiri masses to attain the inalienable right of theirs, i.e. self-determination.

The current phase of agitation in India- Held Kashmir is also rooted in the struggle of the Kashmiri people for the exercise of the right of selfdetermination. Pakistan upholds the right of the people of Jammu and Kashmir to self-determination, in accordance with the resolutions of the provide for the holding of a free and impartial plebiscite for the determination of the future of the state by the people of Jammu and Kashmir.

The basic points of the UN resolution are that: (i) the complaint relating to Kashmir was initiated by India in the Security Council; (ii) the Council explicitly and by implication, rejected India's claim that Kashmir is legally Indian territory; (iii) the resolutions established self-determination as the governing principle for the settlement of the Kashmir dispute. This is the world body's commitment to the people of Kashmir; (iv) the resolutions endorsed a binding agreement between India and Pakistan reached through the mediation of the United Nations Commission for India and Pakistan (UNCIP) that a plebiscite would held, under agreed and specified conditions.

The United Nations Security Council has rejected the Indian contention that the people of Kashmir have exercised their right of self-determination by participating in the 'elections' which India has from time to time, organized in the Indian-Held Kashmir. Very low turn out during the 'elections' held in 1989 and 1996 is a clear repudiation of the Indian claim.

Pakistan continues to adhere to the UN Resolutions. These are binding on India as well. Rather than respond in a responsible and democratic manner, India has resorted to genocidal repression, and over 75 thousand Kashmiris have been martyred since 1989 when

this popular and indigenous movement gained momentum. Over the recent months, the level of violence and brutalities has been raised with the induction of additional forces, in addition to 700,000 already in Jammu and Kashmir.

The Kashmiris in the Indian-Held Kashmir and fighting for their rights, and hence cannot be termed as terror-

The 9th Extraordinary session of the Islamic Conference of Foreign Ministers held in Doha on October 10, 2001, has stressed its rejection of any linkage between terrorism and the rights of the Islamic and Arab peoples, including the Palestinian and Lebanese peoples, to self-determination, self-defense, sovereignty and resistance against Israeli and foreign occupation, all of which are legitimate rights enshrined in the United Nations Charter and international law. The United States also recognizes Kashmir as a disputed territory between Pakistan and India, and in his recent visit to these countries, US Secretary of State Mr. Colin Powell stressed the resolution of this issue through dialogue and also offered his government's readiness to mediate in case both countries agree to it. Pakistan has absolutely no hesitation

Q: Frankly speaking, Yemenis oppose Pakistan's government's stance concerning the strikes against the Afghan people. How could you convince Yemenis that Pakistan made the right decision?

A: First of all I would like to clarify that campaign against terrorism is not against the Afghan people, rather it is aimed at terrorists and those who are harboring them. The terrorist attacks of 11 September triggered worldwide shock and horror, evoking condemnation of the criminal acts, grief and sorrow for the victims, condolences for the families and sympathy and solidarity with the people of the United States, governments including those of OIC countries voiced these sentiments spontaneously. The government and the people of Yemen condemned the terrorist attacks; so did we. Our position is clear and emphatic. The people of Yemen we believe have full understanding of the circumstances under which our government has made the decision to extend all our support for the anti-terrorist campaign. The government of Yemen has also appreciated our position, which is based on principles supported by the UN General Assembly and the OIC countries.

Q: Does the Pakistan government tionally.

agree on a new government without the Taliban?

A: Our President General Pervez Musharraf, in this regard, has clearly lain down four parameters for such a government. Firstly, the unity and stability of Afghanistan must be ensured. Secondly, to have a broad-based multi-ethnic government representative of all the ethnic groups, taking into account the ethnic composition of Afghanistan. Thirdly, we must not ever be seen to be imposing a political solution on the Afghans. We should be seen as facilitating a solution, and the solution needs to be in accordance with the wishes of the people of Afghanistan. Lastly, Pakistan would certainly like to have a friendly Afghanistan on its western border. When we say that the process has to be developed by the Afghans themselves, then it will have to include all the Afghans who are outside and more importantly, I should say, all the Afghans who are inside Afghanistan. There may be 25 to 30% who are outside Afghanistan, but there may be 7-75% of Afghans who are inside Afghanistan; they will have to be inducted in this process. Of course, this is the challenge for the United Nations - how to bring about national reconciliation.

Q: What is the truth in the reports that several Yemenis in Pakistan or Pakistanis in Yemen were arrested with the suspicion of being involved in terrorist activities?

A: There is no truth in the reports that Yemenis have been arrested in Pakistan. However, we have come across a new item that appeared in the Arabic daily 'Al-Thawra' on October 30, 2001 in which a statement of a Yemeni national who was studying in Karachi University was published. According to his statement, he was arrested by the security agencies who investigated him and later permitted to resume his normal life. He returned to Taiz on October 14. Regarding arrest of Pakistanis in Yemen, so far not a single case of arrest of a Pakistani is in the knowledge of this

Q: How do you assess, from a Pakistani point of view, the Yemeni government's stance in this crisis?

A: We greatly appreciate the decision of the government of Yemen for extending their support for an antiterrorist campaign. I feel that such a decision will go a long way in improving Yemen's image as a responsible member of the world community and strengthen its position both domestically and interna-

arrival of the of month Ramadan, say-"Welcome ing, the month of fasting." For the most part, all people duly observe the rituals of the holy month of Ramadan in


ways that show the fear of and obedience to the Almighty God. During daylight,

one could notice the quietness that prevails in the city as streets become semideserted. In contrast, at nighttime the markets become very crowded as people go to shop and to meet their friends. Only one thing disrupts the tranquillity of this month - qat markets - as many people go to purchase qat before sunset or after breaking the fast. Reciting the

Quran is one of the most visible characteristics of this month, as you see people sitting and reading verses of the Holy Quran. Indeed, many people could finish reading the Holy Quran twice or thrice during this month. At the time of breaking the fast, people sit and call on the Almighty God to accept their fasting and prayers as well as to make them succeed in their life.

Despite the availability of so many forms of media which are used for announcing the time of fast-breaking, such as radio and television, the fastbreaking cannon installed at al-Qahira Castle is still one of the most unique characteristics of Ramadan in Taiz. All people await the firing of the cannon, marking the end of day. Concerning the meals served at the fast-breaking time, most people usually have light dishes, but always starting with dates and after that "shafut" (small pieces of bread mixed with yogurt), which is one of the most special meals of Ramadan. After nighttime prayers most people begin having the main dishes which are very diverse. Meanwhile, nightlife becomes more lively as people go to meet their friends at cafes and others go to qat meetings.

Mosques in Ramadan are not merely for prayers, as they have become a place for learning the Holy Quran and the other religious sciences. Following nighttime prayer, many religious lectures are performed, which last until early morning. Ultimately, the holy month of Ramadan is a time of repentance to God; thus we all have to avail this chance to ask for God's mercy through worship and obedience.







Chairman of the Yemen-Gulf Bank, Mr. Mohammed Hassan Al-Zubairi to YT:

"there have been no severe effect of the September 11 attacks, except for the delay in money transfers carried out through American Banks."

he Yemen-Gulf Bank, though a newly established one, has gained good reputation in the Yemeni market. Presently, the bank is considered one of the best banking institutions operating in our country. To shed more light on institution giant Mohammed al-Masani met with its Head of Board of Directors, Mr. Mohammed Hassan al-Zubeiri and filed the following report.

Yemen-Gulf Bank

Introducing the Yemen-Gulf Bank, Mr. Mohammed Hassan al-Zubeiri said, "The Yemen-Gulf Bank was established with the aim of attracting investment activities by the Gulf businessmen. For them, banks were one of the safest channels of investing their money. There have

been reasons for their choice such as the fact that banks are monitored by the Central Bank which helps control any manipulation and that it is easy to sell one's share when deciding to withdraw."



As far as the Bank's activities in Yemen, al-Zubeiri stated that Yemen's investment law was good. "We have heard that this law will be amended.

There will not be a need to obtain a license for any investment project according to the new law. It will be enough to register projects at the General Authority of Investment, after which one can get tax relief. No customs tariffs are demanded for pro-

> duction material and equipment," said al-Zubeiri, describing such facilities as encouraging. He added that security, judicial and administrative difficulties and hindrances will also be abolished with the help of the World Bank and International

Monitory Fund. The Central Bank of Yemen (CBY) blacklisted a number of clients who failed to repay their loans and distributed the list to commercial banks to avoid dealing with those clients. To

avoid such a common problem, al-Zubeiri said the Yemen-Gulf Bank is very careful in regards of loaning. "However," he added, "Any bank expects to have the same problem. Banks can lean on treasury bonds if they want to avoid investment, but this choice does not generate good revenues."

On the subject of the fluctuating price of Yemeni Rial and its consequences

on banks operating in the country, he said it even affects the economy of the country, let alone the commercial banks.


"What adds insult to injury is that Yemen imports everything, which causes inflation," he said. "The (CBY) treats this problem by increasing profits of its treasury bonds which helps compensate losses caused by deterioration of the price of the local

currency," he added.

It is worth mentioning that the price of Yemeni Rial has lost more points to the US dollar after the September 11 attacks on New York and Washington. The events have also affected banks but al-Zubeiri said there have been no severe effect of the September 11 attacks, except for the delay in money transfers carried out through American Banks.

At the end of the interview he expressed hopes to build good relations with the (CBY). "I am sure that the (CBY) is more concerned about establishing a sort of partner relations with commercial banks," he said, adding Yemen's economy, guaranteeing shareholders' rights, protecting the country's currency, etc., concern all commercial banks not only the

وقد رافقت الانتخابات في كثير من المحافظات أحداث شغب، فاحد الطلاب في الحديدة ما زال في غرفة العناية المركزة، وطورد الطلاب في جامعة ذمار، و٦٢ طالباً فصلوا بسبب ترشيحهم ومشاركتهم في الانتخابات.. وغيرها.

وقد قامت «يمن تايمز» بالنزول الميداني، واستمعت إلى آراء وتعليقات الطلاب وأساتذة الجامعات فكانت هذه الحصيلة:

كبيراً ونسبة المرشحين وصلت الى ٦٠٠ مرشح داخل «إرادة الطلاب كانت اقوى من قرار الحكومة الجامعة عدا الفروع»، وأضاف قائلاً: «إن مشكلة الدولة وتصريحات الحزب الحاكم وادارة الجامعة والأمن» هكذا بدأ باسم الحاج – نائب رئيس اللجنة التحضيرية أنها تتجه نحو الشمولية وإلغاء الهامش الديمقراطي حديثه، واستطرد قائلاً: «رغم المعوقات التي واجهناها، وتفريغ مؤسسات المجتمع المدني من محتواها، وشق لكنا مضينا بحماس كبير وخلفنا حشود الطلاب، لأن النقابات وتفريخ الاحزاب»، ويرى أن موقف رئاسة رؤيتنا تقوم على اساس الطوعية والاستقلالية وعدم


الجامعة سلبي وأن الاتحاد جماعة ضغط ليس ضمن

على المصلحة الطلابية وليس لمصلحة اي جهة اخرى»، وأضاف: «لم يكن هناك استعداد من قبل الطلاب لهذه الانتخابات واللجنة التحضيرية الحالية، مشكلة من حزب واحد، والمرشحين هم اللجنة الاشرافية والتحضيرية والناخبون،، وعلق على الانتخابات بقوله: «انها مسرحية هزلية تتم بطريقة عشوائية فاقدة للتنظيم

ويحدد وسيم القرشي - رئيس اللجنة الاشرافية كلية الطب، المشكلة بأن الاتحاد واقف بين مطرقة وزارة الشؤون الاجتماعية وسندان عدم الشرعية ، وقال: «بان مشروعية الاتحاد وقوته تنشأ من الطلاب وليس من الاعتراف، ويرى ان مقاطعة المؤتمر ليس لها أي أثر انما يكمن دوره بمحاربتنا من قبل قوات الامن وأن المؤتمر لم يدخل الانتخابات لانه يفتقد الى القواعد الطلابية، وأن لديه حب السيطرة، وإن تم لهم ذلك في الانتخابات النيابية لان الشعب اقل وعياً فان الطلاب اكثر وعياً ويعطون ثقتهم لمن يمثلهم ويثقون به. وعن رأيه في ادارة الجامعة قال: «إنهم لا يحاربون هذا العمل بدافع ذاتي وانما كما اخبرونا بانفسهم بأن لديهم أوامر
